- The school will provide well equipped Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board. The
 relevant books as per the academic level of students shall be made available in the library.
- 7 The School should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers and would ensure computer student ratio of 1:20 at least. Proper software along with facility of Broad Band connectivity with the feature of internet always on from any service provider to be ensured.



To purchase, take onlease or in exchange, hire or otherwise acquire any lands buildings and other property, to erect and maintain any buildings on such lands and to enter into any contract or other obligation in connection with the erection of such buildings or the leasing management of any land/building or property of the Charity.

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(1). The Charity and all thereunder shall be non-religious and non-political. Proselytizing is not permitted.

(j). To invest the monies of the Charity not immediately required upon such securities including the securities of the mortgage of any lands, buildings, messuages or tenements or the mortgages, debentures, funds, shares or securities of any corporation or company as may be decided by the Trustees in a meeting and opinion of the majority will be accepted in all cases:

(k). To pay gratuity or allowance if the Charity becomes liable to pay to such employees upon retirement in accordance with law2

(1). To publish material about the Charity and sell products for the benefit of the Charity. For & on behalf of FUTTINE HOPE INDIA

3. The Trustees shall be entitled to make regulation for the service conditions of the employees to be employed by the Trustees from time to time for carrying out the sime and objects of the Charity. The employment of staff and acceptance of volunteers is at the sole discretion of the Trustees. Their employment or dismissal is at the sole discretion of the Trustees:

4': The Trustees shall be entitled to receive funds from the general public and to open and operate Bank Accounts by such number of Trustees as may be decided and authorised in a meeting by resolution.

The Trustee shall continue in his office until he or she dies, becomes invalid or becomes insolvent or is removed by majority of the Trustees from the trust or resigns as Trustee, and upon the happening of any such event, the remaining Trustees say nominate and appoint a successor who shall

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

The plan submitted by you was scrutinized and marked as found necessary from Fire Safety point of view. In returning one set of plan with recommendation, this is issuing Fire Safety Recommendation in favor of the aforesaid building subject to the compliance of the following fire safety measure.

Recommendation:

CONSTRUCTION:

- The whole construction of the existing building shall be carried out as per approved plan drawings conforming the
 relevant building rules of local Municipality Body.
- 2. The interior finish decoration of the building shall be made low flame spread materials conforming I.S. specifications.


